GENERAL TERMS AND CONDITIONS BINDING THE TENDER SALE FOR THE DISPOSAL OF SCRAP MATERIALS

- 1. Inspection of Lots:** The Purchaser/Bidder may inspect the materials/lots as per schedule of disposal.
- 2. Inspection of the lots shall be done by all prospective bidders with prior intimation over phone (07324-306958) to satisfy themselves about the quality and condition of the materials.**
- 3. No request for samples or inspection / complaint what so ever will be entertained after submission of the Tender. No dispute with reference to description/condition etc. of the items/lots will be entertained. Mis-description by the institute on the details of the lot/unit due to inadvertence will not invalidate this tender sale.**
- 4. Bidders/tenderers are requested to quote their competitive offers in terms of each lot and unit as the case may be, BOTH IN WORDS & FIGURES in the enclosed format. Overwriting/Corrections & Mutilation is not allowed. However, Corrections, if any, is/are to be attested with full signature. Offers received in any other form will not be considered. OPEN Tenders will be rejected.**
- 5. E.M.D./BID SECURITY :** Offers shall be valid for consideration only if they are accompanied with sufficient EARNEST MONEY DEPOSIT[EMD]equivalent to the value of 10% (Ten Percent) of the total bid amount quoted in respect of all the Lots/Items or any of them, as the case may be.

No responsibility will therefore be accepted by IITI for the description, condition, completeness, accuracy in size, shape, nomenclature, weight, number, etc., whatsoever and no complaints will be entertained in respect of quality, quantity, condition of the items.
9. **Successful Bidder/s shall lift the complete unit/lot. No picking or choosing will be allowed in the Disposal site/ institute premises by the bidders.**
10. Tax and other statutory levies as applicable under Government rules will have to be paid by the successful bidders at the time of payment of the bid amount in full. The bidders/tenderers are requested to quote their **GST Number** invariably in their tender form. Bidders may refer relevant Tax rules of the Govt. of Madhya Pradesh.
11. Valid tenders will be processed for further action, after their opening as scheduled. Written intimation to the successful bidder/s will be forwarded requesting him/her/them to **pay the remaining 90% of the bid amount within TWO Days**. The successful bidder can lift the item on production of the requisite documents in central stores, and lift the allotted material/s concerned within **TWO DAYS** from the date of issue of the award letter.
12. **The successful bidders shall lift the materials concerned at their cost (i.e. loading/unloading, weighing, clearing, transportation etc.) within the stipulated time after effecting the full payment under valid Gate Pass [Non-returnable].**
13. **In case the lots are not lifted within the specified time Ground Rent equivalent to Rs.200.00 per lot per day will be charged for the period of Seven Days. The materials not so removed will be treated as abandoned lots and EMD and other amount paid will be FORFEITED** without any reference to the bidders.
14. The institute reserves full right to resell the abandoned lots. The bidders will not have any right to claim on those material/s and no correspondence will however be entertained in this regard.
15. The successful bidders who would like to take delivery of the goods through their authorized representative/s should send an authorization letter with their personal identification such as Driving License card, Income Tax PAN card, etc. along with such person/s duly attesting his/her/their signature/s therewith.
16. The tenderers/bidders are requested to submit their competitive offers in the prescribed form with the requisite EMD in a sealed cover duly super scribed as **'TENDER FOR THE DISPOSAL OF SCRAP MATERIALS'**.
17. Tender Documents received in response to this tender sale will be opened in the presence of the bidders who desire to be present.

18. The address given in tender document shall be deemed to be the address of the bidder .All correspondence / EMD refund sent on that addresses shall be considered to have been delivered to the bidder. No claim in this respect will be entertained.

23. For any dispute, the place of jurisdiction shall be Indore, India only.

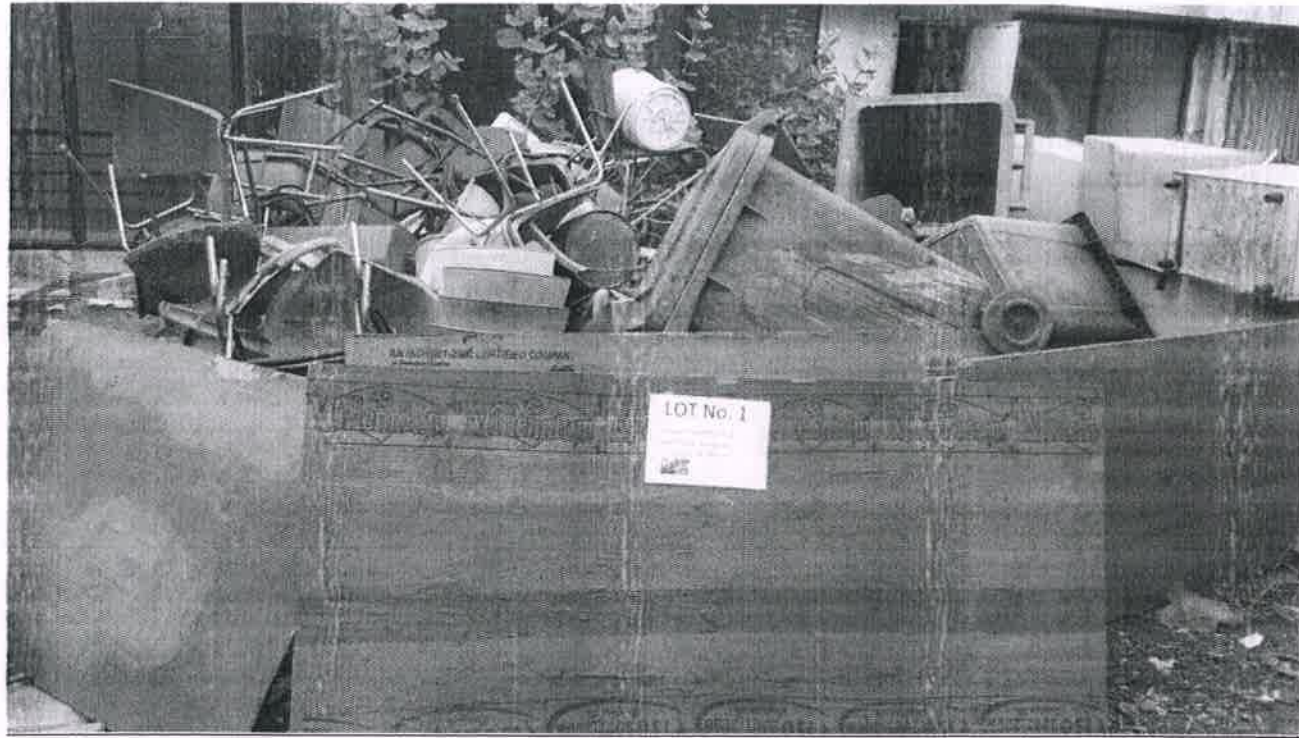

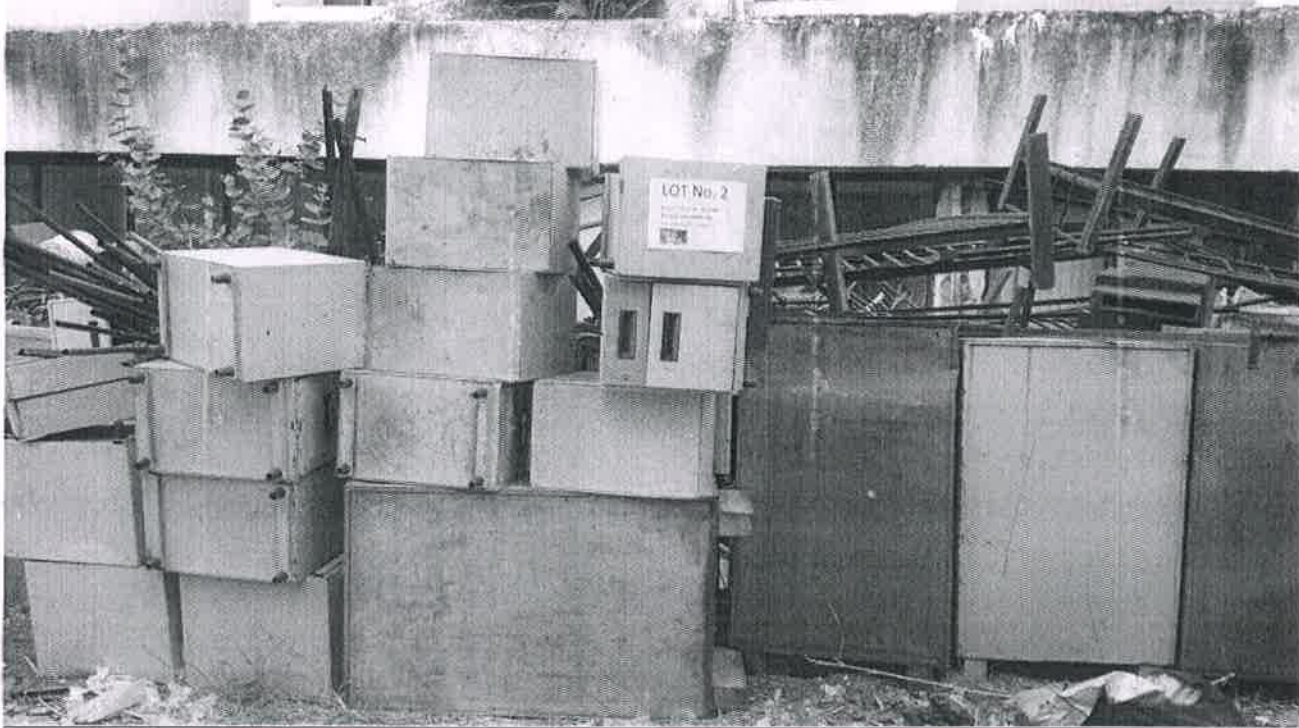

LOT NO. 2 (Unserviceable Metal Furniture Scrap)

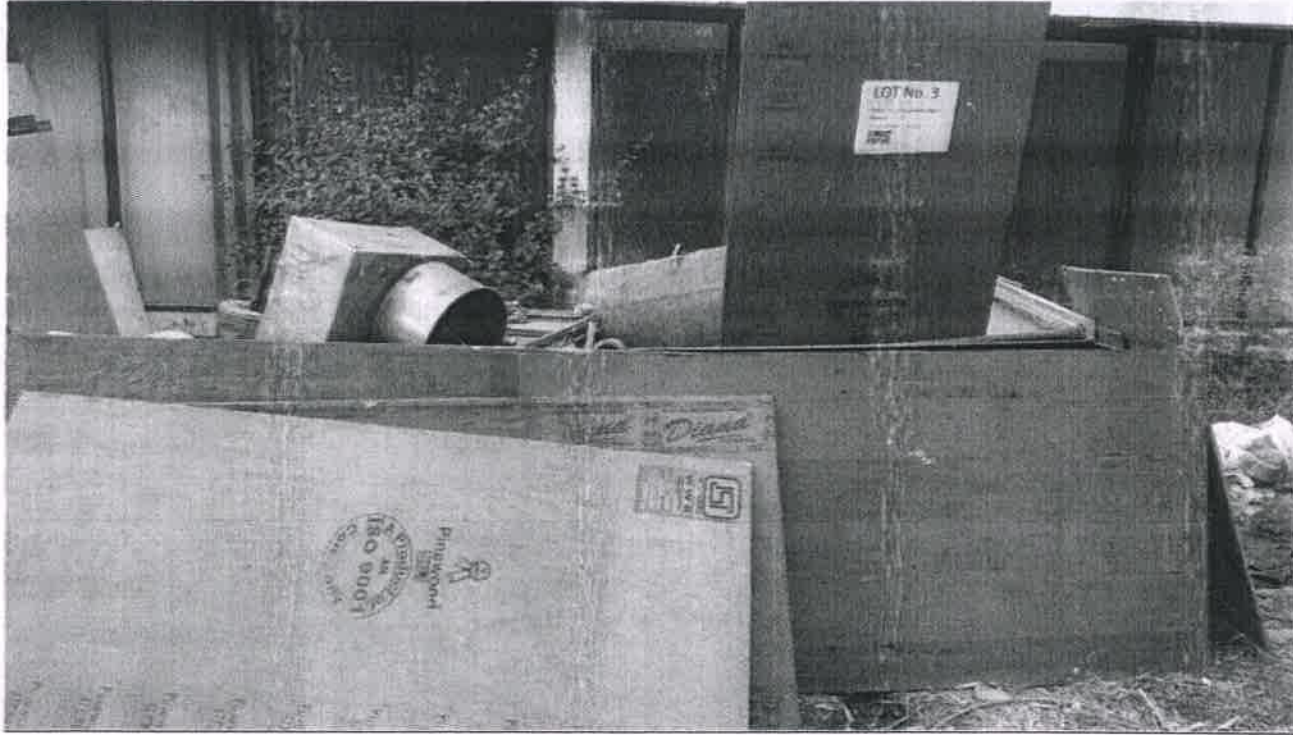

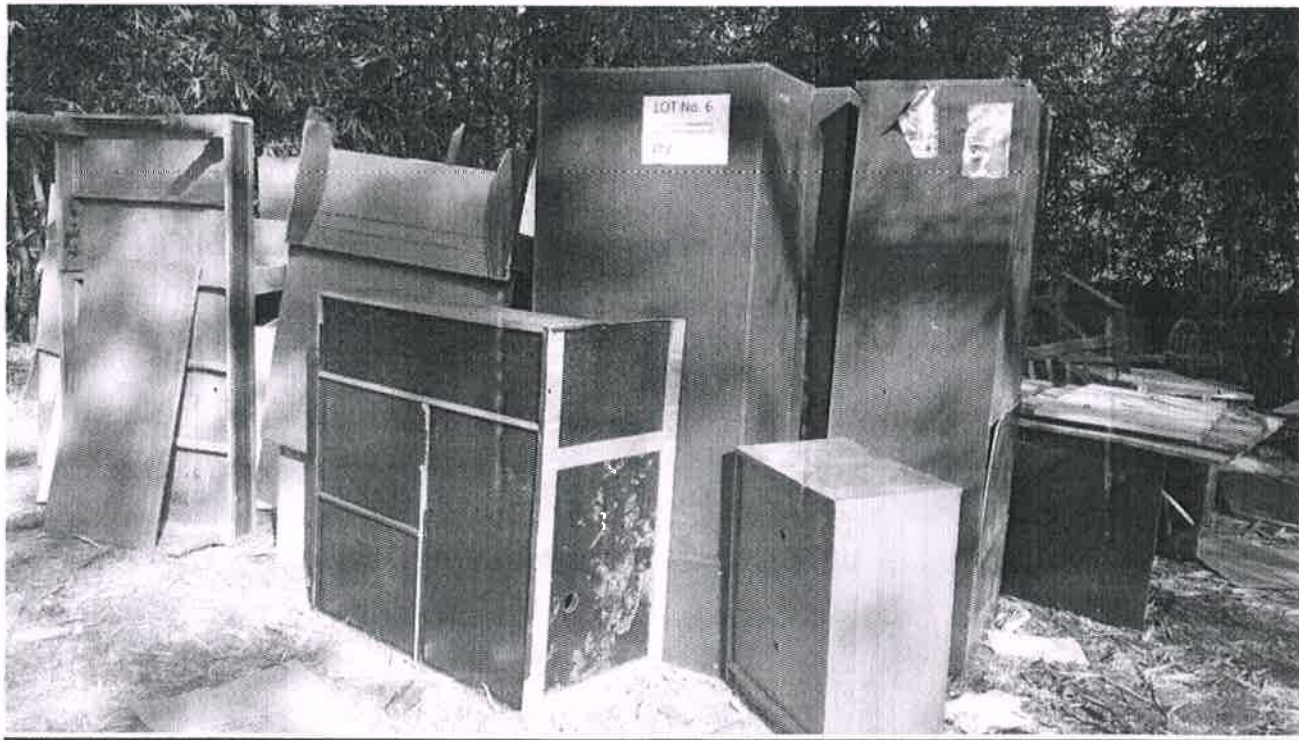
