- 1. Any bidder from a country sharing a land order with India will be eligible to bid in this tender only if the bidder is registered with the Department for Promotion of Industry and Internal Trade (DPIIT) as per vide Ministry of finance OM No. 6/18/2019-PPD dated 23rd July 2020.
- 2. <u>Benefits to Micro and Small (MSEs)/Start-Up will be applicable</u> under PP Policy 2012 from MSEs as per MSE guidelines issued by MoMSME.
- 3. The Public Procurement (Preference to Make in India) will be applicable under Order 2017, DIPP, MoCI Order no. P-45021/2/2017-B.E.II dated 15th June 2017 and its subsequent amendments.
- 4. Payment: No advance payment will be made in any case. Payment will be released through wire transfer/bank RTGS transfer after Supply, installation testing, inspection& commissioning of the item(s) and if found satisfactory with regard to quality, quantity and specifications ordered. The payment will be released after statutory deductions within 30 days. For the payment, the firm has to submit Supplier's Invoice indicating, inter alia description and specification of the goods, quantity, unit price, total value; challans(s), Manufacturer's guarantee certificate; bank details/cancelled cheque, installation report, performance bank guarantee (if asked) etc. to the Assistant Registrar MM Section, IIT Indore.

5. Performance Security:

- a) Magnetic field of ± 9 Tesla with a Magnet charging time of ≤ 10 minutes for 0 to 9T is required.
- b) Magnetic Field ramping data with log data files at maximum rate should be provided. Demonstration may be asked during technical evaluation.
- c) The magnet charging or control modes should be completely software integrated. At the least, there should be linear, oscillating, and no overshoot mode. Vendor should provide data with log files for the magnetic field overshoot in the 'no overshoot' mode for field strengths of 1, 3 and 9 Tesla.

Temperature Control specifications

- a) System must achieve quick and precise temperature control.
 It should offer fully automated, low temperature operation of
 4.2 K for a continuous long time.
- b) Fully automated cooling & warm up operation should be possible in the temperature range of 400 K to 1.9 K. The time required for a cooling down from 400 K to 1.9 K and viceversa should both be under 45 minutes. Provide supporting data with data files. Demonstration will be asked during technical evaluation.
- c) The system must be able to hold the measurement temperature within 0.1% in the temperature range of ≤1.9 K to 20 K under magnetic fields of up to 9T and within 0.02% at temperatures of 20 K to 400 K. Demonstration will be asked during technical evaluation.
- d) Provide temperature stability data with Log files at ≤ 1.9 K at a magnetic field of ± 9 T. Data should be in temperature versus time format collected in the following manner:
 - i) Set sample temperature to 1.9 K at zero-field
 - ii) Stabilize sample temperature at 1.9 K for 10 min
 - iii) Continuously ramp magnetic field to 9 T while recording the temperature

Vendor should provide recorded data with log data files in a, clearly indicating the steps as specified above. Vendor may be asked for a demonstration during technical evaluation.

- e) Data of thermal cycling with Log data files in the following steps should be provided:
 - i) Start from 300 K and set temperature to 2K, move up to 400K and set again to 2K



Repeat the above process for 5 cycles

ii) Finally, once the system reached 2 K for the last time, ramp the field (as fast as it could) to full field (9 T). Then, finally oscillate the field back to 0 T.

Measurement Options

i. DC Magnetization (VSM):

- a) Supported Temperature Range: ≤ 1.9K 400K (specify and provide supporting data).
- b) Magnetic moment noise levels must be less than 6 X 10⁻⁷ emu at 300 K for 1 second integration time and 40 Hz frequency.
- c) VSM measurement data for the temperature range of 1.9K to 400K with 1 second averaging, measured during both cooling and heating must be provided with the offer by the bidders. Data files must be sent along the tender submission. Demonstrations will be asked during technical evaluation. 1 second integration is must for us to quickly resolved Magnetic phase transitions and hysteretic behavior.
- d) VSM system must perform rapid, completely automated centering operations. There should not be any need to perform manual adjustments to center the sample. Vendor must specify the centering process details and travel range of the motor.
- e) At least 3 publications should be attached for 1.9K 400K complete temperature range of VSM measurement by quoted system in support of this measurement/accuracy.
- f) Please provide following measurement data for a sensitive magnetic sample with your offer. Measurement data and data files to be sent along with technical bid. Demonstration of the same may be asked during technical evaluation. The total measurement time must be efficient (<8 hours).
 - (1) Degauss magnet (Set 1 T then Oscillate field to 0 T)
 - (2) Set temperature to base temperature (≤ 1.9 K) Zero field cool sample

(Wait 20 minutes for proper thermalization)

- (3) Set 500 Oe measurement field
- (4) **Measure m(T)** upon warming @ 500 Oe field $(\leq 1.9 \text{K to } 10 \text{ K} \otimes 0.2 \text{ K/min})$
- (5) Set field to 0 T (Oscillate field) and warm up to 300 K
- (6) Zero field cool sample to base temperature (Wait 20 minutes for proper thermalization)
- (7) Measure m(H) @ \leq 1.9 K 0 T \rightarrow + 9 T \rightarrow -9 T \rightarrow + 9 T (5 segment loop) @ 100 Oe/s
- (8) Set field to 0 T and warm up to 300 K

ii. Electrical Transport Measurement:

- (a) Temperature Range: 1.9 K to 400 K (or above)
- (b) Provision for 4-wire & 2-wire resistivity and simultaneous Hall effect measurement
- (c) Provision for measuring I-V characteristics and differential resistance measurement (dV/dI vs. I or dV/dI vs V)
- (d) Two built-in independent sources and meters must be provided to make the two measurement channels truly independent.
- (e) In addition to standard mode (4-wire resistance up 10 M Ω), there should be high impedance mode of 2 wire resistance measurement up to 5 G Ω .
- (f) Current Source: DC & AC, 10 nA (or less) to 100 mA (or more), frequency for ac source: Continuous from 1 Hz to 200 Hz
- (g) Sensitivity: 20 nV or better
- (h) Resistance resolution: 20 n Ω at 0.1 A.
- (i) Setup to check the contacts prior to measurement
- (j) Published data must be supplied in favor of the measurements and accuracy.

iii. Heat Capacity:

- a) Temperature Range: 1.9 K 400 K. Provide supporting information to validate the supported temperature range. Demonstration may be asked during technical evaluation.
- b) Measurement should utilize relaxation technique, two-tau model fit analyses, corrections of back grounds from sample platform and adhesives through main system software. Claim needs to be supported by references of the papers published and patents.
- c) Sample Mass: Typically, few mg.
- d) Measurement Accuracy: less than 5% over 2K 300K.
- e) Heat Capacity resolution: less than 10 nJ/mole.K at 2 K temperature. Vendor must submit measurement data with log data files in support of resolutions claimed.
- f) Thermometers on the platform.
- g) Suitable sample holder to keep the sample along the field direction to protect strongly magnetic while sweeping the magnetic field.
- h) Specify the sample chamber pressure.
- i) A sample mounting station should be included to ensure hassle-free sample mounting.
- j) Sample heat capacity as a function of temperature as well as measurements under a constant field should be available.
- k) At least 2 publications should be attached in support of Heat capacity measurement from 1.9 K – 400 K by the quoted instruments.

iv. Data acquisition and analysis:

- a) Licensed Windows based operating software and computer control system compatible with the measurement options.
- b) Sample measurement should be fully automated. The software shall control all aspects of the instrument's electronics, hardware, gas handling, data acquisition and data analysis. The software should include a comprehensive sequence editor for setting up unattended measurement runs. Each user must be able to set their own measurement sequences and data files so experimental set-ups and data are safe on a multi-user system.
- v. Water Chiller Unit: A high-quality water chiller unit with suitable capacity for trouble free continuous running of the main system should be offered.

vi. Future Upgrades:

The system must be field upgradable to add measurement options including Dilution refrigerator option for mK operation, Broadband ferromagnetic resonance, Torque Magnetometry, Thermal expansion measurements like Dilatometer, etc. Supporting data/documentation sheets must be attached by the bidder in support his claim.

vii. Other Details:

- a) The requested data along with data files should be send within the tender deadline date to mms@iiti.ac.in.

The imposition and duration of the exclusion will be determined by the severity of transgression and determined by the Principal/Owner. Such exclusion may be forever or for a limited period as decided by the Principal/Owner.
- 2) Forfeiture of EMD/Performance Guarantee/Security Deposit: If the Principal/Owner has disqualified the Bidder(s) from the Tender process prior to the award of the Contract or terminated/determined the Contract or has accrued the right to terminate/determine the Contract according to Article 3(1), the Principal/Owner apart from exercising any legal rights that may have accrued to the Principal/Owner, may in its considered opinion forfeit the entire amount of Earnest Money Deposit, Performance Guarantee and Security Deposit of the Bidder/Contractor.
- 3) Criminal Liability: If the Principal/Owner obtains knowledge of conduct a Bidder or Contractor, or of an employee or a representative or an associate of a Bidder or Contractor which constitutes corruption within the meaning of IPC Act, or if the Principal / Owner has substantive suspicion in this regard, the Principal/Owner will inform the same to law enforcing agencies for further investigation.

Article 4: Previous Transgression

- 1) The Bidder declares that no previous transgressions occurred in the last 5 years with any other Company in any country confirming to the anticorruption approach or with Central Government or State Government or any other Central/State Public Sector Enterprises in India that could justify his exclusion from the Tender process.
- 2) If the Bidder makes incorrect statement on this subject, he can be disqualified from the Tender process or action can be taken for banning of business dealings/ holiday listing of the Bidder/Contractor as deemed fit by the Principal/ Owner.
- 3) If the Bidder/Contractor can prove that he has resorted / recouped the damage caused by him and has installed a suitable corruption prevention system, the Principal/Owner may, at its own discretion, revoke the exclusion prematurely.

Article 5: Equal Treatment of all Bidders/Contractors/Subcontractors

- 1) The Bidder(s)/Contractor(s) undertake(s) to demand from all subcontractors a commitment in conformity with this Integrity Pact. The Bidder/Contractor shall be responsible for any violation(s) of the principles laid down in this agreement/Pact by any of its Sub-contractors/sub-vendors.
- 2) The Principal/Owner will enter into Pacts on identical terms as this one with all Bidders and Contractors.
- 3) The Principal/Owner will disqualify Bidders, who do not submit, the duly signed Pact between the Principal/Owner and the bidder, along with the Tender or violate its provisions at any stage of the Tender process, from the Tender process.

Article 6: Duration of the Pact

This Pact begins when both the parties have legally signed it. It expires for the Contractor/Vendor 6 months after the completion of work under the contract or till the continuation of defect liability period, whichever is more and for all other bidders, till the Contract has been awarded.

If any claim is made/lodged during the time, the same shall be binding and continue to be valid despite the lapse of this Pacts as specified above, unless it is discharged/determined by the Competent Authority of IIT Indore.

Article 7: Other Provisions

- 1) This Pact is subject to Indian Law, place of performance and jurisdiction is the Head Quarters of the Division of the Principal/Owner, who has floated the Tender.
- 2) Changes and supplements need to be made in writing. Side agreements have not been made.
- 3) If the Contractor is a partnership or a consortium, this Pact must be signed by all the partners or by one or more partner holding power of attorney signed by all partners and consortium members. In case of a Company, the Pact must be signed by a representative duly authorized by Board Resolution.
- 4) Should one or several provisions of this Pact turn out to be invalid; the remainder of this Pact remains valid. In this case, the parties will strive to come to an agreement to their original intensions.
- 5) It is agreed term and condition that any dispute or difference arising between the parties with regard to the terms of this Integrity Agreement / Pact, any action taken by the Owner/Principal in accordance with this Integrity Agreement/ Pact or interpretation thereof shall not be subject to arbitration.

Article 8: Legal and Prior Rights

All rights and remedies of the parties hereto shall be in addition to all the other legal rights and remedies belonging to such parties under the Contract and/or law and the same shall be deemed to be cumulative and not alternative to such legal rights and remedies aforesaid. For the sake of brevity, both the Parties agree that this Integrity Pact will have precedence over the Tender/Contact documents with regard any of the provisions covered under this Integrity Pact.
