The MoU was signed by prof Suhas Joshi, director, IIT Indore and Dr Michael Harms, deputy secretary general, DAAD, Germany.

Dr Philipp Ackermann, German Ambassador to India shared his views on strengthening partnerships between Indian higher education institutes and



German universities. DAAD and the IIT Indore recognise the reciprocal benefit of academic and scientific cooperation between scientists of both countries in areas of mutual scientific interests. Under this agreement, the faculty members from IIT Indore and German universities will engage in re-

search and academic collaborations.

DAAD is an organisation of German higher education institutions that promotes the internationalisation of academic programmes by providing funding to faculty and student exchange programmes from all over the world.
