Details of the Post

The essential and desirable education, qualifications, and experience for the advertised post are as follows:

Veterinarian (Visiting Consultant)

Essential Qualification:

1. Bachelor's degree in veterinary science & animal Husbandry (BVSc &AH) as listed in the 1st & 2nd Schedule of the Indian Veterinary Council Act, 1984 with 2 years of experience.
2. Must have a valid registration issued by state veterinary council/ Veterinary Council of India.

Desirable Qualification: - 1. Master of Veterinary Science (M.V.Sc.) in Veterinary Medicine or Veterinary Microbiology or Veterinary Pathology or Veterinary Pharmacology and Toxicology with a valid registration issued by state veterinary council/ Veterinary Council of India.

2. PhD candidates in relevant subjects or with experience will be preferred.
3. Good communication skills should be a high-energy individual, organized, and self-driven.

Minimum Experience: Veterinary science & Animal Husbandry.

Desirable Experience: 1. Practical experience in animal handling techniques, scientific breeding, maintenance, and care of laboratory animals, esp. small animals like rats, mice, rabbit, guinea pig etc.

1. Experience in managing lab animal house facility.
2. Experience in handling and maintaining lab animals including immunocompromised animals, specific pathogen free animals and genetically modified animals.
3. Experience in managing BSL-2 studies.
4. Experienced in minor animal health monitoring procedures and related documentation.
5. Experience in environmental monitoring of the facility.
6. Knowledge of CPCSEA regulations /CPCSEA registration and approval procedures and functionalities of IAEC
7. Experience in working with GLP certified labs.

No. of Visits: The Veterinarian (Visiting Consultant) will be requested to visit on a requirement basis for hours basis.

Job requirements/description:

- Animal house veterinarians should ensure that clinical and preventive health programs be implemented effectively in the Animal House Facility.
- Provide orientation to new students/animal users per CPCSEA guidelines and SOPs of Animal Facility.
- Train the new students/animal users/animal caretakers/support staff to humane laboratory animals properly.
- Oversee animal husbandry programs assist users in animal-related procedures like breeding, sample collection, excision of tumors, injections, animal identification methods, euthanasia, etc.
- Should assist Facility in-Charge in importing and exporting live laboratory animals, quarterly animal health monitoring programs as per CPCSEA guidelines (GOI).
- Should be available for emergency veterinary care after work hours, on weekends, and Holidays.
- IAEC meeting coordination and liaison with CPCSEA
- Organizing and co-ordination of IAEC meeting, reviewing and finalization of IAEC protocols and minutes of meetings.
- Development and implementation of animal facility policies related to animal care, research, and safety.
- Any other activity assigned by the IAEC chair from time to time.

Terms and Conditions:

1. The engagement of a veterinarian will be purely temporary and will not confer any right to them to claim the status of a regular employee of the institute.
2. The Veterinarian will not be entitled to any other Allowance or Benefits other than those indicated above.
3. The Veterinarian will abide by the Institution Rules and Regulations governing their engagement.
4. The Veterinarian will safeguard the security and confidentiality of all official matters and the secrecy of information coming to their knowledge.
5. The Honorarium is fixed and there is no scope of negotiation for honorarium or any other allowance.

Termination of Engagement:

The Engagement of the Veterinarian will stand automatically terminated on completion of the prescribed tenure as specified in the Offer of Engagement. The Engagement can be terminated even earlier, with one month's Notice in writing from either side.

Selection Criteria: Certificate Verification and Interview/Interaction.

General Instructions:

1. Experience will be reckoned on the last date of submission of the application.
2. Candidature of the applicant shall be subject to verification of testimonials at a subsequent stage, i.e., at the time of Interview/Interaction. In case the candidate fails to submit the required supporting documents (as mentioned by them in their application /CV), his/ her candidature shall not be considered for the interview.
3. Applications received through incomplete / not in the prescribed format without relevant documents will not be considered.
4. Applicants will not be paid any amount towards their travelling/other expenses to appear in the practical test/interactive session.
5. Short-listed applicants for Interview/Interaction and finally selected applicants only will be informed individually via e-mail correspondence at their registered e-mail addresses.
6. Only shortlisted applicants will be called for the Interview/Interaction.
