

IIT Indore invites applications for the position of Wellness coordinator in the Wellness Centre at the Institute. The Institute is a residential campus housing more than 3000 students. The wellness coordinator is a person who can mingle with the students, help them during their physical and mental health problems and give them the boost needed to finish their education with flying colours. The details of the position are as follows:

Job Profile/Responsibilities:

- (a) A wellness therapist helps people who struggle with health problems and cope with them.
- (b) WT provides counselling services to clients to help them to cope with psychological problems.
- (c) WT will work with a team of therapists, psychiatrists and doctors to build a healthy environment and also provide a holistic support to mental health problems of the clients.
- (d) Clinical psychologist should also offer individual and group therapy sessions to patients.
- (e) WT should conduct regular awareness training for supporting staff and the Institute community to make them aware of mental health and mental hygiene.
- (f) Maintain case records and prepare reports of each patient.
- (g) Wellness therapists are required to be reside on campus hostel. They should also be available to attend to an emergency at any time.
- (h) Good oral, written skills, ability to communicate adequately with diverse community of students, and staff member

Duration: Engagement is purely temporary on a contractual basis, initially for a period of one year and renewable annually, based on the satisfactory performance and discretion of authorities of the Institute. Contract tenure will commence from the date of joining.

Selection Procedure: Written test / interview will be held at the IIT Indore campus for shortlisted candidates. Merely qualifying the eligibility criteria does not entail an application to be shortlisted.
