Applications are invited from highly motivated and eligible candidates for the following positions at the JPNCOEH at IIT Indore.

The Postdoctoral Fellow and the Field Investigator will work on the main research area of "Environmental Humanities." The main themes of research will be on Natural Resource Conservation, Tribal Cultures and Environmental Justice and Allocation of environmental resources. The position will be initially for six months and extendable to another six months based on the performance.

(i) Postdoctoral Fellow (One Position):

Eligibility:

Essential: PhD in Economics/Education/Sociology/Political Science/Philosophy/Social Work. The candidates should have experience and specialization in the area of environmental humanities. The candidates must have understanding of quantitative, geospatial and qualitative research methodologies and survey techniques.

Desirable: Drafting of reports and presentation skills. The candidates should have excellent command over English and Hindi.

(ii) Field Investigator (One Position):

Essential: Bachelors or Masters Degree in any discipline with preference for Economics/Education/Sociology/Social Work/Development Studies/Public Health. The candidates must have understanding of quantitative and qualitative research methodologies and survey techniques. The enthusiasm and ability to interact with diverse stakeholders is essential.

Salaries:

- (i) Postdoctoral Fellow: Rs. 58,000/- per month as consolidated emoluments.
- (ii) Field Investigators: Rs. 20,000/- per month as consolidated emoluments.

Service Conditions:

(i) The positions are **not** eligible for any kind of Dearness Allowance (DA), House Rent Allowance (HRA), Medical Allowance, Travel Allowance, etc. However, the candidates will be eligible for OPD at the institute Medical Clinic.

(ii) Travel related to the project will be reimbursed as per institute rules.

Duration: The appointment is for a period of 6 months. The appointment is on purely temporary for the duration of the project.
