Minutes of the twenty second (22nd) meeting of the Board of Governors held at 11.00 a.m. on Friday, July 21, 2017, at Board Room, School Building, IIT Indore, Simrol.

Professor Pradeep Mathur, Director, IITI and Chairperson, BoG welcomed all the members and special invitees present in the meeting. He informed the members that this meeting is a re-scheduled meeting which was earlier scheduled to be held on June 20, 2017, but could not be conducted due to lack of quorum and needed to be adjourned.

The Chairperson on behalf of Board welcomed Mr. R.P Dwivedi, Registrar and Secretary, BOG who joined the Institute recently.

Prof. Pradeep Mathur also mentioned that he is convening the Board's meeting as Chairperson on the directive of MHRD, GOI till the new Chairperson of BoG is appointed. Despite several reminders to MHRD the Chairperson of Board has not been appointed for the last one year. It was also mentioned that reconstitution of the Board by nominating four non-ex-officio members is also awaited. Board asked the Registrar to keep on pursuing the matter with MHRD.

The Chairperson informed that IIT Indore has been ranked 15th amongst Engineering Institutions by NIRF ranking-2017. The Institute has been maintaining top position amongst all new IITs for the 2nd consecutive year. IIT Indore continues to be a preferred institute for many high ranking JEE qualifiers. This year, 03 students from the top 1000 rank have joined IIT Indore.

It was also apprised to the Board that despite the locational disadvantage in comparison to other new IITs the placement record of the Institute has been excellent. The Institute has started new academic programme in Civil Engineering and Metallurgy Engineering and Materials Science. Number of patents and consultancy projects are increasing. The Institute has been organising national/international conferences, seminars, symposia frequently.

The Chairperson informed that his recent visit to TU9 and US has been fruitful. He met many Indian prospective faculty candidates who want to return to India and who are not aware about information to apply in IITs. The rolling advertisement of faculty position in the Institute has a rolling application of more than 100 at any point of time indicating the potential academic excellence of the Institute in national and international level for teaching and research.

Despite problems with construction agency the Constructions Work of Phase-I have been completed to approximately 80%. However, the construction company is finding very difficult to complete the remaining work.



During the discussions, one of the Board members, Dr. William Selvamurthy applauded the achievement of IIT Indore particularly the excellent campus coming up. The old system of using bicycles strayed here and there, has been replaced with pollution free energy saving E-Carts which are open to all students, faculty, staff and visitors to go from one point to other within the campus. The use of green vehicles makes the Institute stand out among other Institutes and is a healthy model for other institutes and organisations to follow. Such an environment also fosters academic and research talks and deliberations beyond conventional classrooms and contributes positively to the academic life of a student on campus. Other members agreed.

He further suggested that IIT Indore should be cradle of innovation in contemporary and disruptive technology by industrial connects and collaborations. This institute may also tie up in strategic sectors by networking with other research organisations such as DRDO, CSIR, ICAR, ICMR etc. The Institute should further augment technology in the Institute and should be a model to other IITs in such an endeavor too.

BOG/22/2	Overview report by the Director.
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The overview report has been made part under agenda item No. BOG/22/1 as the Director had chaired the meeting.

BOG/22/3	To confirm minutes of the twenty first (21th) meeting of Board of Governors held on March 11, 2017.
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Minutes of the twenty first (21st) meeting of the Board of Governors were circulated to all the members and no comments were received. The Board confirmed the minutes of the meeting.

BOG/22/4	To consider and take note of the Action Taken Report (ATR) on the minutes of the twenty first (21st) meeting of Board of Governors.
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The action taken report was presented before the Board during the meeting. While recording its satisfaction on ATR, the Board discussed the following:-

- (i) 21.2(v) - Stone pelting incident has been reported on the car of one of the faculty members from some unruly elements near one of the openings in the boundary wall.

Though the situation was controlled with assistance from the local police, Mr. Aman Singh, member, BOG suggested to take up the matter at higher level with the State Government. Mr. Sabhajeet Yadav, member present from MP Govt. assured to assist in the matter.

- (ii) 21.4 - It has informed to the Board that the Statutes for the new IITs are being processed for necessary approval and the Statutes of IIT Hyderabad have been taken as model. The Institute had framed its own draft Statutes keeping in view the vision, mission, growth resemblance, location, working environment, academic scenario etc.

The Board suggested to the Institute to write to Ministry, if at this stage, those items which are different or in addition to those of IIT Hyderabad could be incorporated.

BOG/22/5	To consider and approve the recommendation of 16th and 17th Finance Committee meeting held on June 20, 2017 and July 12, 2017 respectively.
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The drafts minutes of 16th Finance Committee meeting [Revised] held on June 20, 2017 and 17th Finance Committee meeting held on July 12, 2017 have been sent to MHRD for their perusal before placing for signing of Chairman, FC. The response from MHRD is awaited.

The Board deferred the agenda.

BOG/22/6	To consider signing of Memorandum of Understanding between the Department of Higher Education, MHRD, GOI and Indian Institute of Technology Indore for the year 2017-2018.
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While considering the proposal for signing of MOU with MHRD, the Board decided to have a look towards the documents sent by Ministry for this purpose. The Board authorised the Director to constitute a committee to go through the documents received from the Ministry and give the recommendations. The Board also authorised the Director to sign the MOU on behalf of IIT Indore. The work is to be done within a time frame as decided by the Director.

BOG/22/7	To consider the proposal of delegation of powers to Ministries / Departments for payment of Sitting Fee in respect of Non-officials of Committees / Panels / Boards etc.
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The Board approved the proposal for implementation.



BOG/22/8	To consider the proposal for appointment of Visitor's Nominee on Selection Committee for the posts of Professors in Various Department / Centres of IIT Indore.
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The Board resolved to adopt the list of visitor's nominees of IIT Bombay till its own list is approved under the new Statutes and the same may be communicated to MHRD, GOI.

BOG/22/9	To consider and approve Dynamic Assured Career Progression (DACP) Scheme up to Senior Administrative Grade (SAG) level in respect of Medical and Dental Doctors.
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The Board resolved to adopt the proposal.

BOG/22/10	To consider appointment of Dr. Vilas Pol as Adjunct Professor in IIT Indore.
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Dr. Vilas Pol is presently serving as Associate Professor at the University of Purdue and has been very productive and recognized in the U.S. through various awards and laurels. The Board was informed about the academic excellence of Dr. Vilas Pol and the efforts of the Institute to attract exceptional Indian talents from abroad as part of academic endeavour of the Institute. It was also informed that there is no financial implication on the Institute with the appointment of Dr. Pol as Adjunct Professor.

The Board resolved to approve the proposal to appoint Dr Vilas Pol as Adjunct Professor initially for a period of one year.

BOG/22/11	Items for Ratification :
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The following agenda is placed for ratification:

- 1. To ratify the proposal of medical coverage for scientists under DST Young Scientist Scheme.**

The Board ratified the proposal with an annual limit of Rs. one lakh. The rules stand amended accordingly.

2. To ratify the signed Memorandum of Understanding (MoUs).

The Board ratified the MOUs signed by the Institute with the following advice :-

- i. There shall be an internal committee for periodical review on the achievement of the objectives and outcome to be placed before the BOG.
- ii. The information related to signing of MoUs may be communicated to Ministry and clearance may be obtained wherever required.

3. To ratify the Annual Financial Statements for the financial year 2016-17.

The Annual Financial Statements (AFS) of the Institute for the financial year 2016-17 has been recommended by the 16th Finance Committee vide agenda item No. FC/16/4 held on June 20, 2017. The Chairman BOG approved the Annual Financial Statements which were sent to Director, Auditor General Gwalior (Central). While presenting the Annual Financial Statements one of the members suggested to present the outcome/deliverable also.

The Board ratified the decision of Chairman BOG to approve the Annual Statement of Accounts for the F.Y.2016-17.

4. To ratify visit of Director to U.S.A.

- a. Period: May 1-14, 2017: Purpose – On leave.
- b. Period: May 15 – June15, 2017;

Details of events and main theme:

Meetings scheduled at Purdue University, New York City, Chicago and Los Angeles. To meet and discuss on one to one basis with prospective faculty candidates in mid-west, east coast and west coast areas of U.S.A.

To showcase achievements and future vision of IIT Indore to prospective candidates and also others who may be on verge of deciding to return to India.

To showcase, in particular, excellent funding opportunities for carrying out frontline research and other government schemes such as GIAN, VAJRA, etc.

The following agenda was placed before the BOG for reporting and the Board noted the same.

1. To report list of faculty and non-faculty members joined / confirmed / resigned since last meeting.

The Board noted the list of members of faculty and non-faculty staff members who joined/confirmed/resigned IITI since last meeting of the Board.

2. To report foreign visits by Faculty members/Ph.D Scholars.

The Board noted the list of the faculty members/Ph.D scholars who had made foreign visits related to academic and research assignment.

3. To report on visit of Director to U.S.A.

a. Period: May 1-14, 2017: Purpose – On leave.

b. Period: May 15 – June15, 2017;

Visits to Purdue University, New York, Chicago and Los Angeles to meet with and discuss on one to one basis bright Indian post-doctoral associates working in the mid-west, eastern and western regions of USA for identification as potential faculty recruits.

As a result of advance notification of visit, schedules were prepared to meet a number of interested potential faculty candidates, especially for the areas of Astronomy, Mathematics, Computer Science and Engineering and a few from other Disciplines too. In Chicago and New York, assistance of colleague Dr. Siddharth Malu was taken to evaluate the candidates while in Los Angeles, Dr. H. Hablani, co-chaired the meetings. Several candidates have been identified for shortlisting for consideration by the Selection Committee Meeting, others, who attended the meetings have been convinced to apply. One Associate Professor, Purdue University, has been identified to be offered the position of Adjunct Professor.

Overall the visibility of IIT Indore as well as the generally conducive environment for Indians to return to India has been successfully conveyed to a large section of highly qualified Indian Scientists and Engineers in U.S.A.

The Board has taken note of the visit and appreciated the efforts made by the Director for bringing Indian talents back to the nation.

Following items were presented before the Board as recommended by the Senate in 12th Meeting held on July 10, 2017.

(1) Senate/12.4: To deliberate and consider the list of graduating students during 5th Convocation.
